#30 - POS "Communiqué" PDV - CUSTOMER PAYING THEIR INVOICE VIA ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE (formerly known as a Bar chit)

When a member is running a tab, he/she can pay their tab using their accounts receivables. When they elect to use their account receivables, they cannot split the amount and pay one part cash or credit card or debit card and the other part with their account receivables, he/she must pay the total amount using the accounts receivable.

When two members are running one tab, they can split the tab using cash, credit or debit. They cannot split the tab, one member wants to pay using their accounts receivable and the other one wants to pay using cash or credit or debit or accounts receivable.

Example:

2 persons run one tab total is \$10.00

- Bartender opens 1 tab
- 2 people drink
- they want to settle the tab for a total of \$10.00
- one pays \$5.00 cash
- one pays \$5.00 on his/her MasterCard

When a member is running a tab, they can settle the tab using cash and/or credit card and/or debit card.

Under no circumstances can you have multiple payments when members are using their accounts receivable.
